



SPRING CHECKLIST

ROOF INSPECTION

- Check for missing, cracked, or curling shingles
- Look for dark spots or moss growth (could indicate moisture issues)
- Inspect flashing around chimneys, vents, and skylights for damage
- Check for loose or exposed nails
- Look in the attic for leaks, water stains, or daylight showing through

Pro Tip: If you notice shingle damage or leaks, schedule a Comprehensive Professional Inspection before storms hit!

GUTTER MAINTENANCE

- Clear leaves, twigs, and debris from gutters and downspouts
- Check for sagging or pulling away from the house
- Ensure downspouts direct water at least 3-5 feet away from the foundation
- Look for cracks, rust, or leaks in the gutter system

Pro Tip: Clogged gutters lead to roof leaks and foundation damage—clean them out early in the season!

SIDING & EXTERIOR

- Inspect for cracks, holes, or loose panels
- Look for mold, mildew, or water stains
- Check around windows and doors for damaged caulking
- Clean your siding with a gentle pressure wash or hose

Pro Tip: Damaged siding can let moisture and pests in—repair it before it becomes a bigger issue!

WINDOWS & DOORS

- Inspect for cracks in glass or damaged seals
- Check weather stripping for wear and tear
- Clean windows for a clear view of those spring blooms!

Pro Tip: Properly sealed windows and doors help lower energy bills and prevent water leaks.

YARD & DRAINAGE

- Trim overhanging tree branches that could damage the roof in storms
- Make sure the grading slopes away from your home to prevent flooding
- Check patios, decks, and fences for loose boards or nails

Pro Tip: Spring storms bring heavy rain—make sure your drainage is working properly!
